Begins September 15th

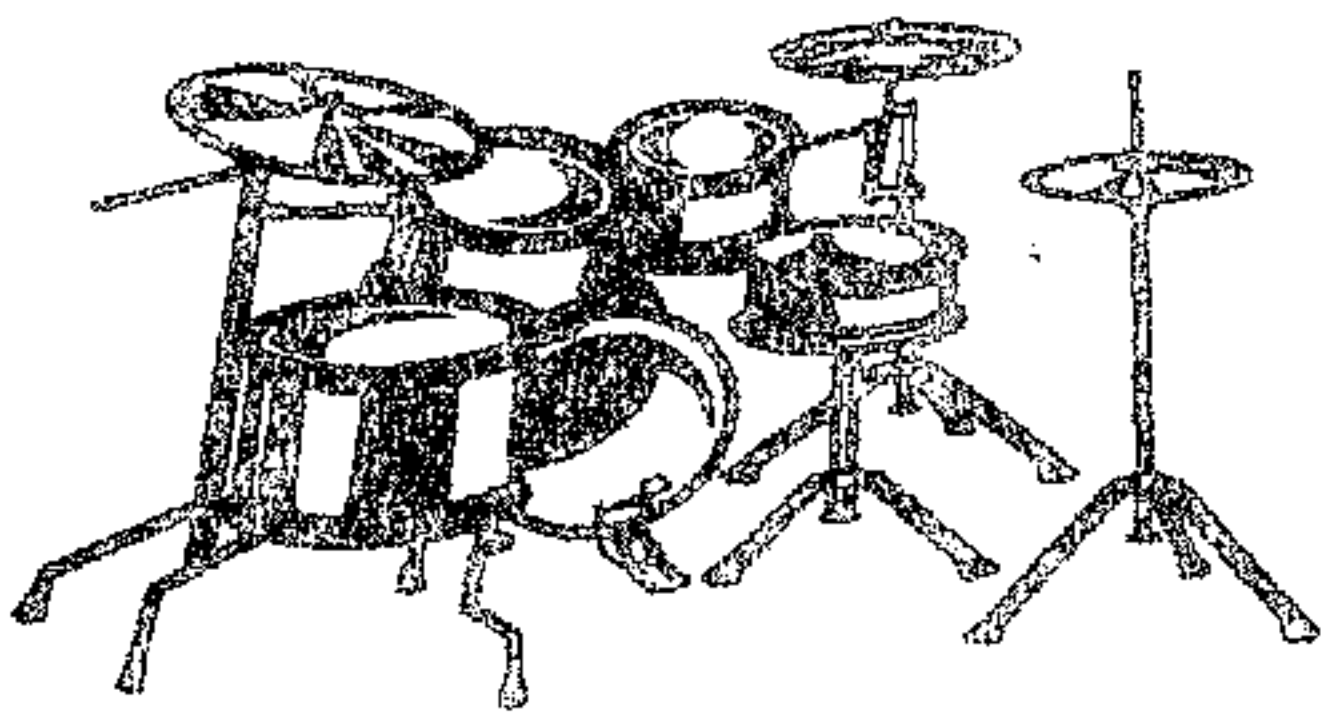

6th – 12th grade youth group will continue to meet on Sunday nights from 6:00 – 7:30pm.

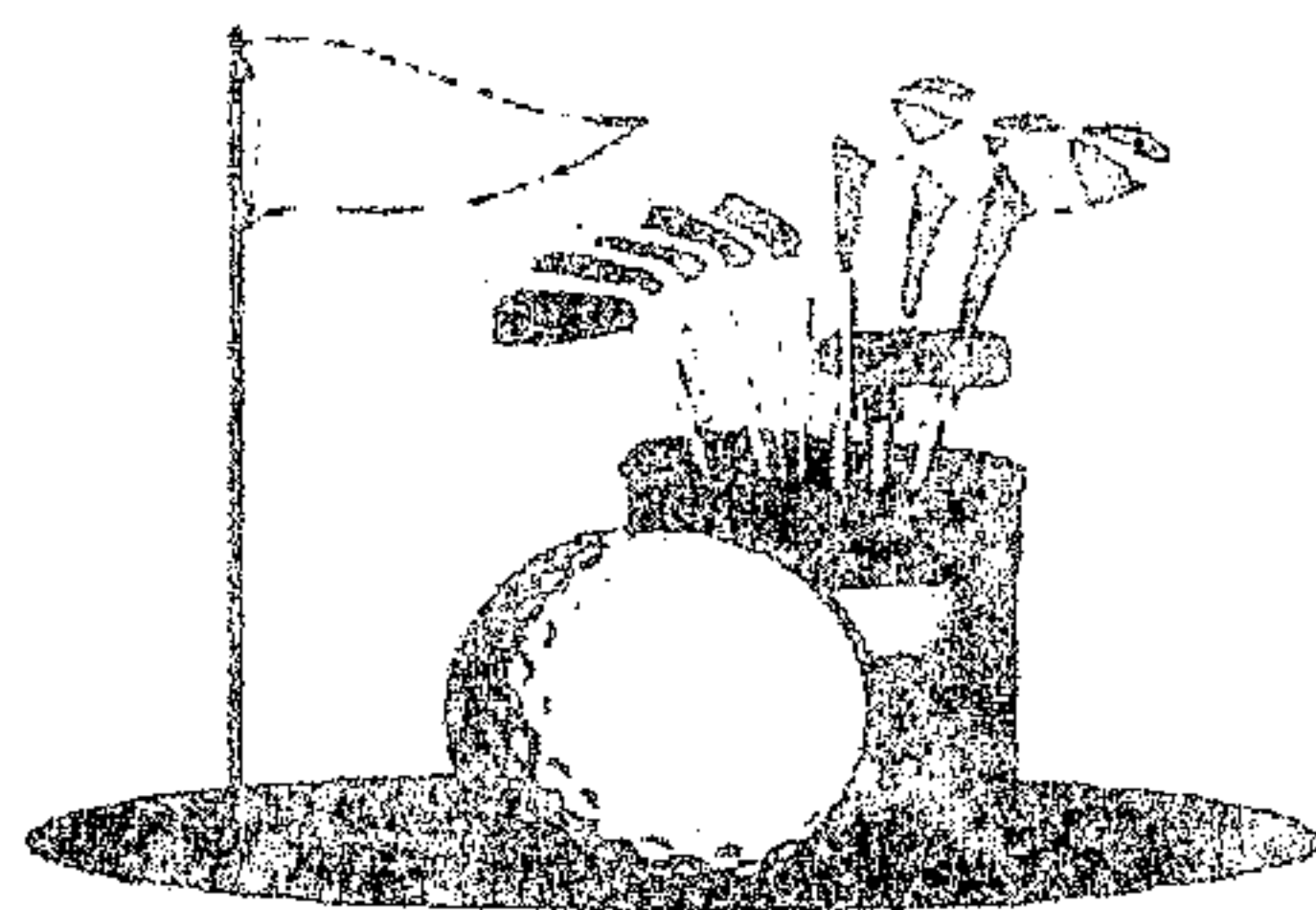

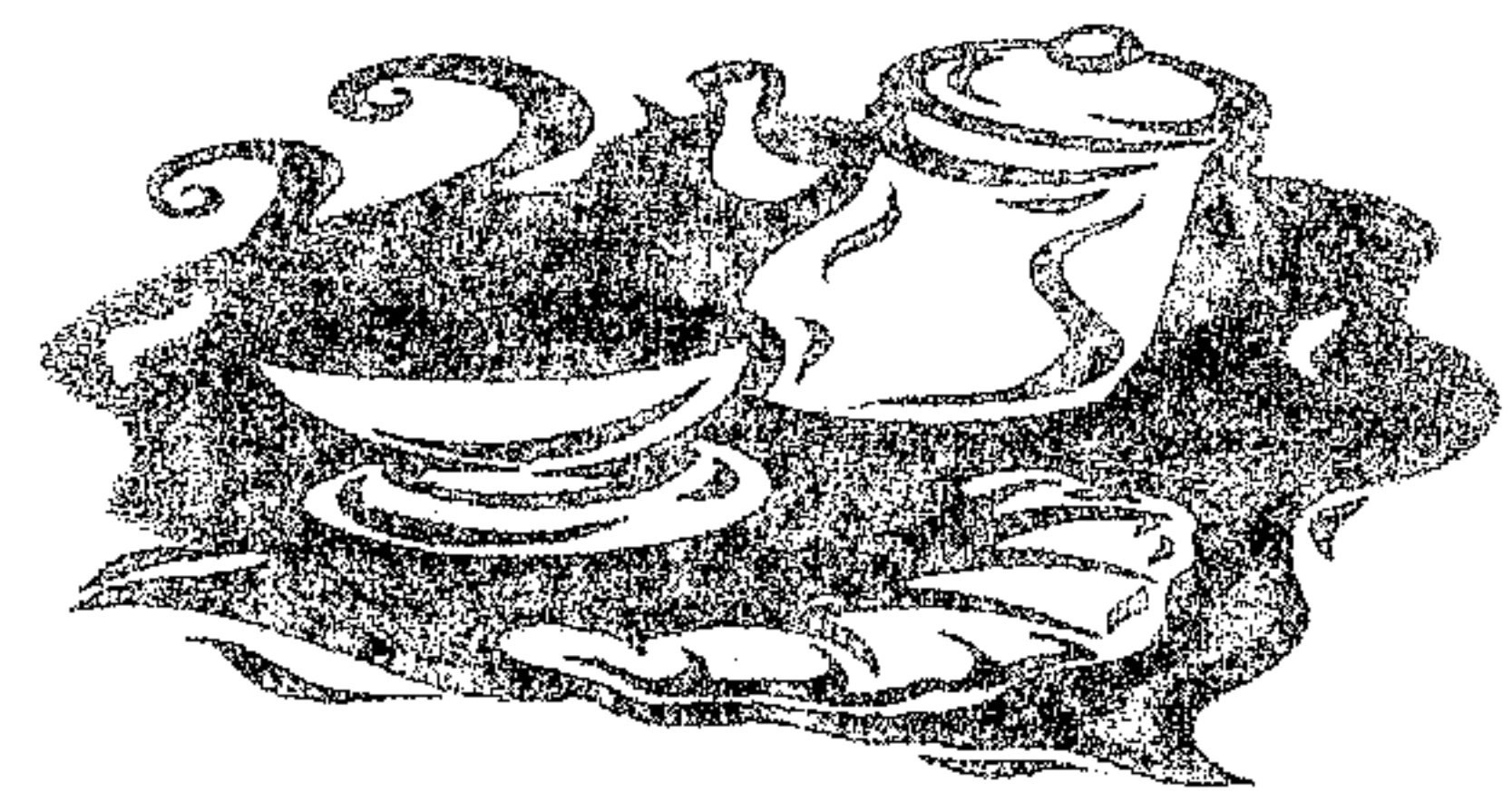

What is God doing for you? (Psalm 23)

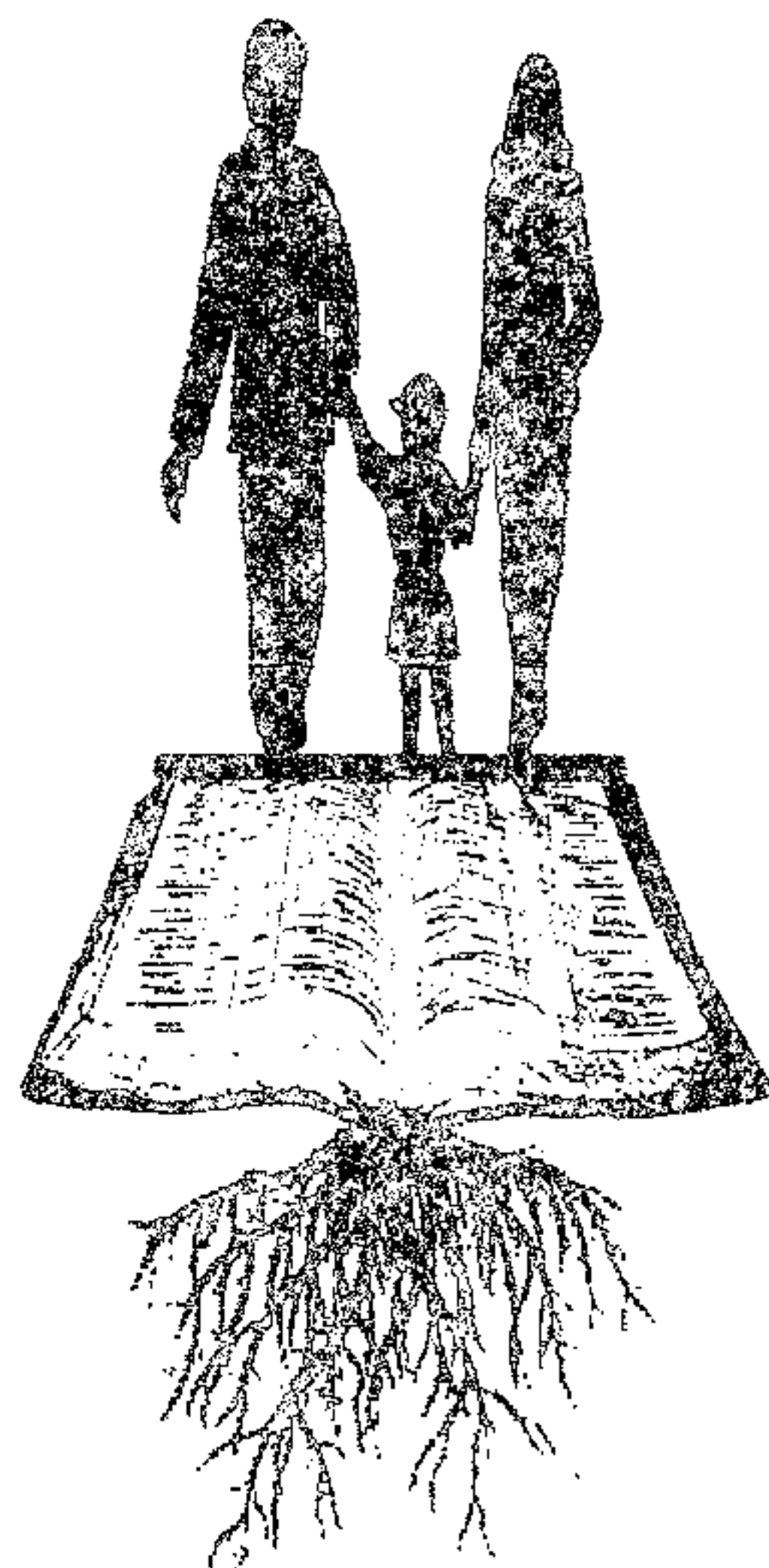
